

STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN OF THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TRADE OF UKRAINE FOR 2017 – 2024

I. PURPOSE (MISSION) OF THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TRADE OF UKRAINE

Purpose (mission) of the Ministry is to create conditions for competitiveness of the Ukrainian economy as a basis for sustainable economic growth and raising standards and quality of human life.

II. ANALYSIS OF CURRENT SITUATION IN THE SCOPE OF ACTIVITY

From the economic decline to macroeconomic stabilization and economic recovery

Analysis of the economic situation in 2016-2018: achievements and challenges, progress and lagging behind the target strategic objectives of the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade of Ukraine.

The economic development of Ukraine in 2016-2018 was primarily characterized by positive developments in the direction of overcoming the negative economic processes and forming the basis for ensuring a sustainable economic growth in the medium term.

In general, after the decline in 2014-2015, real GDP grew by 8.4% in 2016-2018 (in 2016 – by 2.4%, in 2017 – by 2.5%, and in 2018 – by 3.3%). However, such economic dynamics still did not allow to achieve GDP of 2013 – GDP in 2018 made up only 91.3% of 2013 level.

International comparisons. According to Eurostat, in 2016-2018 the GDP growth in Germany was 5.9%, in Great Britain – 5.1%, in Austria – 7.5%, in Denmark – 6.3%, in France – 5.2%, in Sweden – 7.4%, in Estonia – 12.8%, in Latvia – 11.9%, in Lithuania – 10.3%, in Hungary – 11.7%, in Poland – 13.6%, in Slovakia – 10.8%. The overall economic growth in the European Union (28 countries) in 2016-2018 made up 6.6%.

The main source of the economic growth in 2016-2018 were primarily internal factors that contributed to the recovery of positive trends of both investment and consumer demand.

Distinctive feature of the economic development over the last three years has been a considerable increase in the investment activity. During this period, the overall investment demand (GFCF) showed a strong positive dynamics at the level of 59.8% as a whole in 2016-2018, and its role in the formation of the economic growth has increased significantly. Such dynamics led to the development of investment-oriented industries and construction. Positive investment dynamics were supported both by revitalizing of the production activity of enterprises with the formation of positive financial results on this basis in most types of economic activity, and by increasing of the role of budget investment (launch of large-scale investment projects: infrastructure, defense, energy efficiency). In general, a specific weight of GFCF in GDP increased up to 17.2% in 2018 as compared to 15.8% in 2017, 15.5% in 2016 and 13.5% in 2015, and exceeded the level of 2013 – 16.9% of GDP.

International comparisons. According to Eurostat, a specific weight of GFCF in GDP in 2018 in Germany was 20.8%, in Great Britain – 17%, in Austria – 23.9%, in Denmark – 22.4%, in France – 2.9%, in Sweden – 25.5%, in Estonia – 23.9%, in Latvia – 22.8%, in Lithuania – 19.3%, in Hungary – 25.5%, in Poland – 18.2%, in Slovakia – 22%, and in the EU countries as a whole (28 countries) – 20.5%.

In its turn, Ukraine's higher ranking in the **Global Innovation Index** (43 in 2018 as compared to 64 in 2015) also testifies to the recovery of country's innovation potential.

Inflation on the customer market in recent years has been characterized by a modest growth of consumer prices and substantial slowdown of producer prices. In 2016, it was possible to suspend the deployment of inflation flywheel and reduce the consumer inflation down to an acceptable rate of 12.4% per annum, as compared to 43.3% in 2015. In 2017, the specific circumstances in agriculture, some inertia in shifting the effect of rising production costs to final consumer prices, along with high dynamics of raw material and food prices on the global market increased the rate of increase in consumer prices up to 13.7%. However, the overall tendency to slowing down of the inflation processes has clearly shown in a rapid trend towards the decrease in

producer prices, which in 2017 dropped more than twice as compared to 2016 (16.5% and 35.7% respectively), and are currently quite comparable to consumer market prices. The dynamics of inflation processes in 2018 testifies to strengthening of market tendencies and gradual optimization of the economic processes, in particular in the formation of prices with the decrease in sensitivity to overall dynamics towards local shocks. As a result, in 2018 the consumer inflation, for the first time since 2013, decelerated down to single digits and made up 9.8% (industry inflation slowed down to 14.2%).

With relatively low inflation rates and according to overall economic recovery trends, the Government has been able to **significantly accelerate the processes of improving social indicators in terms of population income, pension and salary**. So, if in 2016 the real salary growth made up 9% (under the conditions of decreasing unified social tax), then in 2017 it was 19.1% (the increase in minimum salary up to UAH 3,200), in 2018 – 12.5% (under the conditions of migration outflow of employees and improving financial position of enterprises, which have become main incentives for more rapid increase in salary level than the increase in minimum salary). As a whole, over three years, the actual available income of population increased by 24.3% and actual salary – by 46%. In general, actual salary exceeded the level of 2013 by 9%.

For reference. The nominal average monthly salary of full-time employees in 2018 increased by 24.8% and reached UAH 8,865.

At the same time, the increase in the level of remuneration for labor, as well as expansion of modernization processes contributed to **the recovery of labor productivity growth per capita** (in 2018 – by 2.0%, in 2017 – by 3.2%, and in 2016 – by 3.5% as compared to “minus” 0.8% in 2015). Prior to the level of 2013, the labor productivity made up 108%.

International comparisons. According to the World Bank, GDP per capita (according to Purchasing Power Parity of 2011) in 2018 in Ukraine amounted to 19,095.3 international dollars (in 2017 – 18,294.4 international dollars, in 2013 – 19,093.7 international dollars), and in the EU countries as a whole – 84,319.8 international dollars, in Germany – 91,357.9 international dollars, in Poland – 60,538.3 international dollars, in Latvia – 55,844.2 international dollars, in the Czech Republic – 67,718.9 international dollars.

In general, the growth of industrial production in 2016-2018 against the background of various negative factors indicates a gradual reformatting of production activity in some industries (“plus” 1.6% in 2018, “plus” 0.4% in 2017, and “plus” 2.8% in 2016 as compared to “minus” 13% in 2015).

It should be noted that in 2017 **a share of foreign economic activities in the GVA structure using the technologies of high-level technological treatment increased** up to 0.6% as compared to 0.4% in 2013. At the same time, a share of foreign economic activities in the GVA structure of medium-high level of technological treatment decreased down to 2.6% as compared to 3.6% in 2013.

For reference. According to the Ministry of Economic Development, the growth rates of production using high technologies amounted to 0.7% in 2013, 10.6% - in 2016, 7.7% - in 2017, and 0.7% - in 2018. Medium-high technologies: in 2013 – “minus” 15.8%, in 2016 – 0.7%, in 2017 – 11.4%, and in 2018 – 6.4%.

International comparisons. According to Eurostat, in 2011 a share of foreign economic activities in processing industry in the GVA structure using technologies of high-level technological treatment in the EU countries (27 countries) constituted 1.3%, medium-high level of technological treatment – 5.1%.

The growth of machine building production (“plus” 1.6% in 2018, “plus” 7.9% in 2017, and “plus” 2% in 2016 as compared to “minus” 14.1% in 2015) **and gradual decrease in the GDP energy intensity** (down to 0.267¹ in 2016 as compared to 0.282¹ in 2015) show the formation of domestic investment demand for investment products with high value added and the increase in the efficiency of using energy resources in the production activities, although the indicators are far beyond the European level.

International comparisons. According to Enerdata, in 2017 the GDP energy intensity of Germany made up 0.08 toe/thousand international dollars (according to prices of 2005), France – 0.09 toe/thousand international dollars (according to prices of 2005), Romania – 0.07 toe/thousand international dollars (according to prices of 2005), Poland – 0.10 toe/thousand international dollars (according to prices of 2005), whereas that of Ukraine amounted to 0.25 toe/thousand international dollars (according to prices of 2005).

According to table data “costs-output” for 2017 in the consumer prices in the GVA structure of processing industry, a share of machine building constituted 16.8%. In the EU countries (27 countries) in 2011 – 30.4%.

Moreover, **foreign trade indicators are gradually improving**. According to the National Bank of Ukraine, in 2017 there was a transition from a halt in the decrease of exports (by 3.9% in 2016) to its growth. Total worth of exported goods and services in this year increased by 17.1% as compared to 2016. In 2018, this positive dynamics continued, and volume of exported goods and services increased by 9.7%. This took place against the background of the expansion of integration processes with the European Community (according to the National Bank of Ukraine, a specific weight of exported goods and services to the EU increased up to 37.1% in 2018 as compared to 35% in 2017, 32.1% in 2016, and 30% in 2015) and under the better foreign economic conditions for main goods of domestic export. The leaders of Ukrainian export remained foodstuffs and raw materials used for production thereof as well as metallurgical products.

For reference. According to the State Statistics Service, physical volumes of exported goods and services in 2018 decreased by 1.6% as compared to the increase by 3.8% in 2017, the decrease by 1.8% in 2016 and by 13.2% in 2015.

In 2017, in the export structure of processing industry a share of production using high technologies made up 2%, medium-high technologies – 16.7%.

International comparisons: According to Eurostat, in 2011 in the export structure of processing industry a share of production using high technologies in the EU countries (27 countries) made up 15.5%, medium-high technologies – 51.2%.

According to the National Bank, in 2018 the total worth of imported goods and services increased by 12.6%, in 2017 – by 19.2%, in 2016 – by 4.5% as compared to previous periods. The largest specific weight in the imported goods belonged to commodities intended for investment purposes (in 2018 “Machines, equipment, vehicles and devices” – 28.6%, volumes of such imported goods increased by 17.8%). In other words, modernization of the economy continues laying the basis for future economic development.

For reference. Pursuant to the Association Agreement between Ukraine and the European Union covering the issues of free trade, the total worth of exported goods to the EU countries increased by 15.6% in 2018 (specific weight in the total volume of exported goods – 37.6%). The total worth of imported goods from the European Union countries increased by 12.1% (specific weight in the total volume of imported goods – 36.8%).

A considerable number of actually available target indicators identified by the strategic objectives of the Ministry of Economic Development have been achieved, that testifies to the effective implementation of the economic policy measures pursued by the Ministry of Economic Development in accordance with its main tasks and functions in the area of creating the conditions for technological breakthrough and creating the conditions for economic independence.

However, there is still a large number of lasting negative factors that have accumulated as a result of crisis situation over recent years, and which to some extent restrain the acceleration of further positive development, leaving a substantial number of risks and unresolved problems. These include a low share of R&D in the GDP structure (0.48% in 2016, whereas the EU average (28 countries) constituted 2%) and GVA of production using high- and medium-high technologies in the GVA structure (3.2% in 2017, whereas the EU average (27 countries) constituted 6.4%), low foreign direct investments (only 2.2 bln. US dollars in 2016, and in 2007-2008 this figure amounted to more than 9 bln. US dollars), high GDP energy intensity (in the leading EU countries the energy intensity level is 2-3 times lower) and the material intensity (0.87 points in 2017 in Ukraine, whereas according to Eurostat, the GVA material intensity in the EU countries (27 countries) in 2011 amounted to 0.44 points).

Challenges and risks of further development

The existing model of the Ukrainian economy, which was formed at the turn of past socialist model, **is still characterized by excessive and inefficient administrative burden, as well as a lack of competition** – the main tool of market economy that stimulates economic entities to increase the production efficiency, reduce the production costs, raise the production quality (goods, works, services), accelerate the introduction of latest achievements of science and technology. Another characteristic of this model is

preservation of a substantial share of state-owned property. Loss-making, non-competitive state-owned enterprises destroy the economic system potential and prevent institutional and technological transformation.

Another **systemic problem of Ukraine's development is the consumer model of the economy, which gives rise to short-term development cycles – from crisis to crisis, and actual complete suppression of long-term factors – investments and innovations.** Among the obstacles hindering the development of the investment innovation model, which is specific to highly developed world economies, the following should be noted: low motivation and business interest in radical upgrade of production capacities (as well as focus on “quick small benefits”), consideration of Ukraine by potential foreign investors mainly as the country bearing with high investment risk, weak movement towards capital protection, low use of public-private partnership mechanism in the implementation of infrastructure and innovation projects, outflow of talented employees in all areas of activity and, in general, a lack of the model of state support to innovation development. In addition, the existing state system of legal protection of intellectual property is unable to ensure the development of intellectual property sector as an important element of the national innovation system and the basis of the innovative economy of Ukraine.

Another problem of Ukraine's development is the predominance of raw material export-oriented productions of III and IV technological level (since 1930 and, accordingly, 1970 – completion of rapid growth phase), which depend on the global market cycles. With the expansion of V technological cycle (since 2010 – completion of rapid growth phase) and the transition of the developed countries to VI technological cycles (2010 – commencement of technology development, since 2018 – the period of widespread occurrence), preservation of such structure of industry and export causes the delay in Ukraine's development and eventually turning it into the country capable only of adopting the production technologies whose markets will be moved to the group of third world countries. Therefore, a large-scale structural reconstruction is needed, which must be directly related to resolution of systemic problems: preservation of high energy intensity and material consumption, significant import dependency and technological lagging. Ukraine has also the grounds for accelerated development of defense industry – protection of sovereignty and state independence. Under the conditions of military actions in the territory of our state, illegal annexation of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, development of the defense industry is of great importance. New weapons designed to comprehensively address the tasks of hitting the target and preserving lives of civilians and military men, preventing the spread of aggression, as well as new communication tools must become an integral part of the development of domestic defense industry.

Therefore, **in the future, in view of the continuing problems in the economy, it is necessary to intensify, in the next scheduled periods, the innovative development of domestic production, renew the production capacities and diversify the sales markets, including the expansion of domestic market.**

Based on the challenges currently faced by Ukraine and considering the role of the Ministry of Economic Development in the processes of country's transformation, the main strategic objectives are defined as follows:
